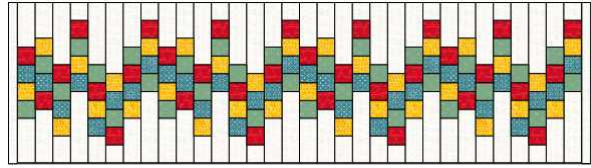


# Scrappy Crumbs Table Runner

Pattern by Ledine Watson  
of Sugar Stitches Quilt Co

Finished size 18" x 66"



## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

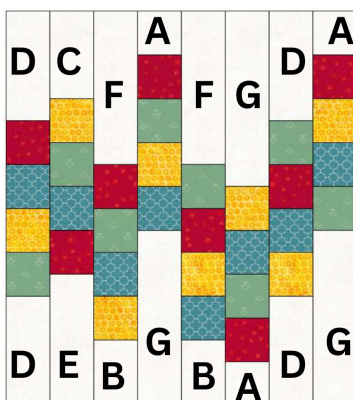
- $\frac{5}{8}$  yard total from a variety of fabric
- $\frac{3}{4}$  yard background fabric
- $1 \frac{1}{3}$  yard backing
- $\frac{3}{8}$  yard binding

## CUTTING

- Cut (128)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares from a variety of fabrics of your choice
- Cut (10)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips from the background fabric
- And then subcut:
  - (12)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares (A)
  - (8)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (B)
  - (4)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (C)
  - (16)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (D)
  - (4)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (E)
  - (8)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $7 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (F)
  - (12)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (G)
  - (2)  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $18 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (left and right borders)
- Cut (5) (8)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips from the binding fabric

## ASSEMBLY

1. Layout (32)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares from your variety into (8) columns. Add the background squares and rectangles according to the reference letters above and the layout below.



2. Sew each column of squares and rectangles.
3. Press the seams toward the darker fabric.  
NOTE: This pattern does not require matching of any seams, therefore, you can press in any direction you prefer.
4. Sew the columns together.
5. Press the seams open or to one side.
6. Trim the block to  $16 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $18 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
7. Repeat to make (4) blocks total.
8. Sew the (4) trimmed blocks together.
9. Sew (1)  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $18 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the left and right for the side borders.
10. Press the seams outwards.
11. Quilt and bind your table runner and you're done! Tag me in your final projects @SugarStitchesQuiltCo and use the hashtag #scrappycrumbs so others can see your final project!
